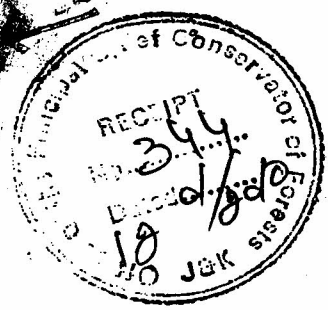
Sanction is hereby accorded to diversion of 0.03 hac. of Forest Land falling in Khasra No. 81 and Khata No. 78 (undemarcated forests) Jammu Forest Division for laying of 132 KV LILO arrangement of 132/33 KV Grid Station, Pouni Chak by PDD in Jammu Forest Division District Jammu on following terms and conditions: -

- I. The Proprietary status of Forest land shall remain unchanged.
- II. The Forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- III. The Forest land in question shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner whatsoever to any other agency.
- IV. The user agency shall pay the following amount: -

i	Net Present Value	= Rs. 19,710/-
ii	Compensation for damage.	=Rs. 39,420/-
Total		59,130/-

- V. The user Agency shall not dump the debris on the Forest land.
- VI. Any damage done to the Forest by his user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from user agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- VII. The Forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the user agency and after it is rehabilitated properly by the user agency.

- VIII. The user agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other Law in vogue.
- IX. The possession of the Forest land diverted for non forestry purpose above shall not be handed over to the user agency till all payments due on account of NPV/compensation of land, compensatory afforestation costs, are deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the Office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests J&K. Before handing over the possession of the land in question it should further be ensured that there are no outstanding dues with the said user agency in respect of the cases sanctioned in the past.
