Sanction is hereby accorded to use of 12.98 ha. of Forest land for dumping of excavated material (Muck) of Chenani Nashri Tunnel at North Portal End in Compartments Nos. 14 b, 14 c and 22/Btt of Range Batote in Batote Forest Division subject to the following terms and conditions :-

1. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
3. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
4. The User agency shall pay the following amount:-

21. Large Scale plantation of native species be undertaken along the right and left reclaimed banks of the stream stretch at the north as well as south portals.
22. Steps shall be taken to protect the spawning sites for fish if any in the area.
23. Regular monitoring of the water quality in terms of turbidity, micro-flora, pH level etc be done and reported to forest department.
24. The money on account of various heads to be paid by the User Agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the office of Pr. CCF, J&K.
