(b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/Social Forestry Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Kashmir. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.

The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls as per approved plan and design of the project and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road. This shall be done under the technical guidance and supervision of the Soil Conservation Department J&K.
- 4. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning the project.
- 5. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 12,25,000/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
