**Subject: - Proposal to allow use of 0.505 hectare of additional forest land for construction of Abutment A-1 and Pier of Mandial Bridge of the External Access Road to Sawalakote Hydro-electric Project by the J&K, SPDC, in Batote Forest Division.**

Sanction is hereby accorded to use 0.505 hectare of additional forest land for construction of Abutment A-1 and Pier of Mandial Bridge of the External Access Road to Sawalakote Hydro-electric Project by the J&K, SPDC, in Compartment No: 73/G of Gandhri Range of Batote Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
3. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
4. The User Agency shall pay the following amount:-

i	Net Present Value	₹ 4,74,195/-
ii	Compensation of trees/poles/Saplings	₹ 24,10,000/-

- (b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/State Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.
6. The Forest Department by obtaining mechanized and improvised ways shall ensure that the young saplings involved are not damaged and safely transplanted (with ball of earth) in the adjoining area with provision of protection and after-care under CAMPA scheme.
7. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land. However, if it is unavoidable, separate proposal for additional use of forest land as dumping site may be moved by the User Agency if not already included in the proposal.
8. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
9. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.

10. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning the project.

11. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 28,84,195/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
