(b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the States: Forest Corporation/State Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.

- The User shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
- 4. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 43,945/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
