Sanction is hereby accorded to use 9.57 hectare of forest land for dumping sites and diversion approaches for Mandial Bridge and Tunnel under Sawalakote Hydro-Electric Project by J&K SPDC in Compartment No: 57, 58, 60, 61, 62, 72, & 73/Gandhri, in Gandhri Range of Batote Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount:-

- 3. The payment of penalty imposed for violation of the Forest (Conservation) Act, shall not be at the cost of the Government exchequer.
- 4. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land other than the dumping sites identified for the purpose.
- 5. The User Agency shall construct retaining/ breast walls around the dumping sites and ensure that the debris dumped is rammed properly using machines/ implements so that it does not get washed away and is stabilized/ rehabilitated properly. This should further be consolidated by planting soil binding species of grass and other vegetation.
- 6. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- 7. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
- 8. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning the project.

- 9. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 2,23,70,410/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
- 10. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.

- 11. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- 12. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
