-Sanction is hereby accorded to felling of 1713 number of trees/poles of Social Forestry Department coming in four-laning of NH-1A from Hanzipora to Pujteng by NHAI "Sangam Strip" Plantation along Hanzipora to Pujteng of Social Forestry Division, Annatnag, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount:-

i	Compensation of trees/poles	₹ 19,92,900/-
ii	Compensatory Afforestation	₹ 3,50,000/-
	Total:-	₹ 23,42,900/-

2 (a) Number of Trees / Poles/ Saplings involved.

(b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/ Social Forestry Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Director, Social Forestry Department. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.



- 2. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls as per approved plan and design of the project and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road. This shall be done under the technical guidance and supervision of the Soil Conservation Department J&K.
- 3. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land.
- 4. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- 5. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
- 6. The User shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
- 7. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 23,42,900/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
