**Subject: - Proposal to allow use of 1.71 hectare of forest land for laying of G.I. Pipe Line from Jai to Chakrabathi and construction of Reservoir, Filtration Plant and Sedimentation Tank by PHE in Bhaderwah Forest Division.**

Sanction is hereby accorded to use 1.71 hectare of forest land for laying of G.I. Pipe Line from Jai to Chakrabathi and construction of Reservoir, Filtration Plant and Sedimentation Tank by PHE in Compartment No's: 30, 31, 32/Jai, 2, 3, 4/Neru, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12/Kellar, of Chiralla, Neru and Kellar Ranges of Bhaderwah Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The user agency shall pay the following amount:-

i.	N.P.V	₹ 15,33,870/-
ii.	Comp. Afforestation	₹ 85,500/-
	<b>Total:</b>	<b>₹ 16,19,370/-</b>

2. Number of Trees /Poles / Saplings involved: Nil.

3. The User Agency shall not be allowed to execute the work till the equivalent State land as agreed by the Revenue Department is transferred to the Forest Department in lieu of the forest land allowed for use as the Compensatory Afforestation of degraded forest has been charged for the equivalent land and not for twice the land allowed for use.

4. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land.

5. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.

6. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
7. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
8. The cheque/draft amounting to ₹ 16,19,370/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
9. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
10. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
11. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
