Proposal to allow use of 2.72 hectare of forest land for construction of approach road from Kulali to Road Tunnel-2/Portal-1, two Portals RT2/P1 and RT2/P2 and a Dumping Yard at RT2/P2 by Northern Railway in Mahore Forest Division.

Sanction is hereby accorded to use 2.72 hectare of forest land for construction of approach road from Kulali to Road Tunnel-2/ Portal-1, two Portals RT2/P1 and RT2/P2 and a Dumping Yard at RT2/, in Compartment No's: 84/Ar & 85/Ar in Mahore Forest Division by Northern Railways, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall deposit the following amount:-

(b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively

- approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.
- 3. The User Agency shall not be allowed to fell two Khair poles involved unless the permission to this effect is obtained by them from the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- 4. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls as per approved plan and design of the project and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the Approach Road and the two Portals. The Forest Department shall take due cognizance under law for any laxity on this account on the part of the User Agency which might trigger soil erosion in the area.
- 5. The User Agency shall construct retaining/ breast walls around the dumping Yard and ensure that the debris dumped is rammed properly using machines/ implements so that it does not get washed away and is stabilized/ rehabilitated properly. This should further be consolidated by planting soil binding species of grass and other vegetation.
- 6. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- 7. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
- 8. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning the project.
- 9. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 29,50,900/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
- 10. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 11. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- 12. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
