Subject: - Proposal to allow use of 0.05 hectare of plantation strip area of Social Forestry Department (State Land) for construction of ornamental Compound Wall around Chowgan at Kishtwar by Kishtwar Development Authority.

Sanction is hereby accorded to use 0.05 hectare of plantation strip area of Social Forestry Department (State Land) for construction of ornamental Compound Wall around Chowgan at Kishtwar, by Kishtwar Development Authority, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount:-

i	Net Present Value	₹ 44,850/-
ii	Compensation of trees/ poles	₹ 1,30,450/-
	Total:	₹ 1,75,300/-

2. (a) Number of Trees / Poles/ Saplings involved:

Species	Trees (30-40 cm and above)	Poles (20-30 & 10-20 cm)	Saplings (0-10 cm)	Total
Broad-Leaved Poplar, Aillanthus & Mulberry	60	71	1	132
Total:	60	71	1	132

(b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/Social Forestry Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Director, Social Forestry Department, J&K.

The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.

3. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning the project.
4. The User Agency shall take up ornamental plantation or plantation of local species such as Deodar (duly protected by tree-guards) all along the compound wall to make the compound wall look vegetatively ornamental as well.
5. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 1,75,300/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
6. The proprietary and legal status of land shall remain unchanged.
7. The land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
8. The land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.


