Subject: - Proposal to allow use of 2.34 hectare of additional forest land for muck dumping of Chenani-Nashri tunnel at North Portal (Km. 130) by NHA in Batote Forest Division,

Sanction is hereby accorded to use 2.34 hectare of additional forest land for muck dumping of Chenani-Nashri tunnel at North Portal (Km. 130) in Compartment No: 22 b/Batote in Batote Forest Division, by National Highway Authority of India, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount:-

i	Net Present Value	₹ 16,35,660/-
ii	Compensation of trees/poles	₹ 1,52,285/-
iii	Compensatory Afforestation	₹ 2,82,555/-
Total:-		₹ 20,70,500/-

2. (a) Number of Trees / Poles/ Saplings involved:

Species	Trees (30-40cm & above)	Poles (20-30cm & 10-20cm)	Saplings (0-10cm)	Total
Chir	13	-	30	43
Broad-leaved Champ	14	35	-	49
Total:	27	35	30	92

- (b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/State Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.
3. The User Agency shall strictly go by the design, engineering and biological measures as per the original muck disposal plan and meet all those parameters set by the committee constituted by the Forest Advisory Committee. The Forest Department shall take due cognizance for any laxity on this account.
 4. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
 5. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
 6. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
 7. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 20,70,500/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
 8. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
 9. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
 10. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
