Sanction is hereby accorded to use 1.58 hectare of State land involved in the Construction new Assembly Complex at Jammu by the JK PCC, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount :-

ii Compensation of trees/poles	₹ 2,67,170/-
iii Compensatory Afforestation .	₹ 1,58,000/-

- (b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/State Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.
- 3. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
- 4. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 14,63,230/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
- 5. The proprietary and legal status of land shall remain unchanged.
- 6. The land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- 7. The land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
