Sanction is hereby accorded to use 138.93 hectare of forest land for construction of 690 MW Rattle Hydro Electric Project at Drabshalla by the JK SPDC in 32 a/Kesh, 37 b/Kesh, 38 a/Kunt, 39/K 67/K in Doda and Kishtwar Forest Divisions, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount prior to execution of Project:-

- (b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/State Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.
- 3. The Forest Department by adopting mechanized and improvised ways shall ensure that the young saplings involved are not damaged and safely transplanted (with ball of earth) in the adjoining area with provision of protection and after-care under CAMPA.
- 4. The User Agency shall not execute the Project until and unless the Environment Clearance from the competent authority is obtained.
- 5. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land other than the dumping sites identified for the purpose.
- 6. The User Agency shall construct the retaining / breast walls around the dumping sites and ensure that the debris dumped is rammed properly using machines/ implements so that it does not get washed away and is stabilized/ rehabilitated properly. This should further be consolidated by planting soil binding species of grass and other vegetation. The Us. Agency shall also ensure that the design, engineering and biological measures as well as the parameters set for safe muck disposal as given in the Muck Management Plan submitted with the Joint Inspection Report are strictly followed in letter and spirit.
- 7. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- 8. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
- 9. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning the project.

- 10. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 14,52,74,140/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
- 11. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 12. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- 13. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by the User Agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency except under the orders of the competent authority of the Government.
