Sanction is hereby accorded to use 1.51 hectare of forest land coming in four-laning of Jammu-Udhampur section (Km 34.000 to 36.100) by NHAI in Compartment No: 1/Jindrah of Block and Range Jindrah of Jammu Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount prior to execution of project:-

- (b) The extraction of trees/poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/State Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.
- 3. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls as per approved plan and design of the project and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road. Any technical guidance required may be obtained from the Soil Conservation Department J&K. The Forest Department shall take due cognizance under law for any laxity on this account on the part of the User Agency which might trigger soil erosion in the area.
- 4. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land. But shall carry it to the dumping sites on non-forest land identified for the purpose. The user Agency shall further ensure that the muck disposed -off is not washed away but stabilized and rehabilitated properly.
- 5. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- 6. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
- 7. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
- 8. The cheque/draft amounting to ₹ 19,67,030/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.

10. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.

9. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.

- 11. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
- 12. The User Agency, at their expenses, shall plant all the small sized poles and saplings in the area under ROW by the mechanized means and ensure their maintenance and watch & ward.
