Subject:- Proposal to allow use of 0.678 hectare of forest land for construction of Parna-Bunda road (from take off point Km. 43 SKS Highway to Bunda) under PMGSY in Marwah Forest Division.

Sanction is hereby accorded to use of 0.678 hectare of forest land for construction of Parna-Bunda road (from take off point Km. 43 SKS Highway to Bunda) under PMGSY in Compartment No: 92/ Udil & 94 b/Udil of Marwah Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount prior to execution of project:-

i)	Net Present Value	₹ 6,08,170/-
ii)	Compensation of trees / poles	₹ 3,05,910/-
iii)	Cost of damage to fencing	₹ 60,000/-
	Total:	₹ 9,74,080/-

2. (a) Number of Trees / Poles/ Saplings involved:

Species	Trees (30-40 cm and above)	Poles (20-30 & 10-20 cm)	Saplings (0-10 cm)	Total
Deodar green	11	4	62	77
Kail green	4	10	14	28
Spruce green	1	-	-	1
Broad-leaved (Robinia & Champ)	0	12	17	29

(b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the CCF, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.

3. The Forest Department by adopting mechanized and improvised ways shall ensure that the young saplings/recruits involved are not damaged and safely transplanted/planted out (with ball of earth) in the adjoining nursery/area with provisions of protection and after-care under CAMPA.
4. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls as per approved plan and design of the project and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road. Any technical guidance required may be obtained from the Soil Conservation Department J&K. The Forest Department shall take due cognizance under law for any laxity on this account on the part of the User Agency which may trigger soil erosion in the area.
5. The User Agency shall not dump the debris on forest land.
6. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
7. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
8. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
9. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 9,74,080/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
10. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
11. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.

12. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.



