**Subject: -** Proposal to allow use of 20.2545 hectare of forest land for construction of Railway Tunnel T-48 (Km. 100 to Km. 110.200) by Northern Railways in Mahore Forest Division.

Sanction is hereby accorded to use of 20.2545 hectare of forest land for construction of Railway Tunnel T-48 (Km. 100 to Km. 110.200) by Northern Railways in Compartment No: 16, 11, 10, 9, 8 and 4/ Ar of Mahore Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount prior to execution of project:-

i	Net Present Value	₹ 1,41,57,895/-
ii	Avenue plantation along open Rly Track	₹ 9,24,000/-
Total:-		₹ 1,50,81,895/-

2. Number of Trees / Poles/ Saplings involved: Nil.
3. The User Agency shall dump the debris only on the dumping sites identified for the purpose on State / Private land strictly as per the guidelines laid down in the Environment Management Plan issued by the M/S National Environment Engineering and Research Institute (NEERI). Any activity generating Muck shall be allowed only after the facility for its disposal has been fully made operational.
4. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.

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5. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
6. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
7. The cheque/draft amounting to ₹ 1,50,81,895/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
8. The proprietary and legal status of land shall remain unchanged.
9. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
10. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
