Subject: - Proposal to allow use of 0.886 hectare of forest land for laying of pipe line from T.P. Drangyari to Chowkibal and construction of PHE structures at Drangyari by PHE Department in Kehmil Forest Division.

Reference: Cabinet Decision No: - 158/24/2012 dated: -05-09-2012 (Agenda item No: 67.05 of 67th meeting of Forest Advisory Committee).

Sanction is hereby accorded to use of 0.886 hectare of forest land for laying of pipe line from T.P. Drangyari to Chowkibal and construction of PHE structures at Drangyari by PHE Department in Compartment No: 12/D, 13/D, 14/D, 15/D & 16/D of Kehmil Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount prior to execution of project:-

i	Net Present Value	₹ 7,94,740/-
ii	Compensation of trees/poles/Saplings	₹ 1,23,200/-
Total:-		₹ 9,17,940/-

2. (a) Number of Trees / Poles/ Saplings involved:

Species	Trees (30-40cm & above)	Poles (20-30cm & 10-20cm)	Saplings (0- 10cm)	Total
Deodar	1	22	39	62
Kail	1	27	43	71
Fir	-	1	2	3
Total:-	2	50	84	136

Note: - (a) Besides, regeneration involving 149 number of seedlings/ recruits of Deodar, Kail and Fir shall also be damaged.

(b) All the trees/ poles/saplings are involved in the laying of pipe line and not in the construction of PHE structures.

- (b) The extraction of trees/poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/ Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Kashmir. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.

3. The Forest Department by adopting mechanized and improvised ways shall ensure that the young saplings/ seedlings/ recruits are not damaged and

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safely transplanted (with ball of earth) in the adjoining suitable area ensuring appropriate safeguards for their protection and after-care under the resources available. It shall be the responsibility of the DFO concerned to ensure that transplantation exercise is completed prior to extraction of trees/ poles and compliance to this effect is reported with full details to his higher ups.

4. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
5. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
6. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning the project.
7. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 9,17,940/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
8. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
9. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indentured.
10. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
