Subject: - Proposal to allow use of 4.39 hectare of forest land for construction of road from Sanzipora to Mankal under PMGSY in Langate Forest Division.

Sanction is hereby accorded use of 4.39 hectare of forest land for construction of road from Sanzipora to Mankal under PMGSY in Compartment No: 38, 39, 41, 42, 43, 44 & 45/ Mawar of Langate Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount prior to execution of Project:-

i	Net Present Value	₹ 39,37,830/-
ii	Compensation of trees/poles/saplings	₹ 11,03,460/-
iii	Compensatory Afforestation	₹ 6,14,600/-
iv	Road side plantation	₹ 20,00,000/-
Total:-		₹ 76,55,890/-

2. (a) Number of Trees / Poles/ Saplings involved:

Species	Trees (30-40cm & above)	Poles (20 -30cm & 10-20cm)	Saplings (0-10cm)	Total

- (b) The extraction of trees/poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/ Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Kashmir. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.
3. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls as per approved plan and design of the project and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road. The Forest Department shall take due cognizance under law for any laxity on this account on the part of the User Agency which might trigger soil erosion in the area.
 4. **The Forest Department by adopting mechanized and improvised ways shall ensure that the young saplings/ seedlings/ recruits are not damaged and safely transplanted (with ball of earth) in the adjoining suitable area ensuring appropriate safeguards for their protection and after-care under the resources available. It shall be the responsibility of the DFO concerned to ensure that transplantation exercise is completed prior to extraction of trees/ poles and compliance to this effect is reported with full details to his higher ups.**
 5. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/ breast walls around the dumping sites and ensure that the debris dumped is rammed properly using machines/ implements so that it does not get washed away and is stabilized / rehabilitated properly. This should further be consolidated by planting soil binding species of grass and other vegetation.
 6. **The Forest Department shall identify suitable area along the road for road side plantation and formulate the project to be processed and implemented under CAMPA**
 7. **The User Agency, in view of the reduced Road Land Width, shall get the DPR revised and approved by the competent authority prior to the execution of the project.**
 8. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
 9. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.

10. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning the project.
11. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 76,55,890/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
12. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
13. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
14. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
