Subject: - Proposal to allow use of 1.859 hectare of un-demarcated forest land for setting up branch of Indian Institute of Mass Communication at Keran (Jammu) by the Higher Education Department.

Sanction is hereby accorded use of 1.859 hectare of un-demarcated forest land in Khasra No. 629 at Keran (Jammu) adjacent to Compartment No: 4/P for setting up branch of Indian Institute of Mass Communication at Keran (Jammu) by the Higher Education Department, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount prior to execution of Project:-

I	Net Present Value	₹ 12,21,360/-
ii	Compensation of trees/poles	₹ 94,400/-
iii	Compensatory Afforestation	₹ 1,30,130/-
Total:-		₹ 14,45,890/-

2. (a) Number of Trees / Poles/ Saplings involved:

- (b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/State Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.
3. The User Agency shall not be allowed to execute the work till an equivalent non-forest land, as assured by the Deputy Commissioner, Jammu, vide his office letter No: DCJ/SQ/IIMC 2012-13/2364-65 Dated: 04.09.2012, is provided to the Forest Department for carrying out compensatory afforestation in lieu of the forest land to be allowed for use.
 4. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
 5. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
 6. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
 7. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 14,45,890/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
 8. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.

9. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indentured.
10. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
