Sanction is hereby accorded to use of 1.39 hectare of Plantation Units of Forest Department coming in the widening of Zozila-Kargil-Leh road (NH 1D) by GREF in Kargil Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount prior to execution of Project:-

i	Net Present Value	Rs. 12,46,830/-
ii	Compensation of trees/poles	Rs. 36,39,200/-
iii	Compensatory Afforestation	Rs. 1,94,600/-
iv	Cost of damage to plantation of Chatithyang Unit	Rs. 14,88,100/-
v	Cost of damage to Barbed-wire, Chain-link fencing, stone walling	Rs. 4,72,500/-
Total:-		Rs. 70,41,230/-

2. Number of Trees / Poles/ Saplings involved:

3. The plantation area shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
4. The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Conservator of Forests, Central Circle. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.
5. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls as per approved plan and design of the project and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed widening of the road. The Forest Department shall take due cognizance under law for any laxity on this account on the part of the User Agency which might trigger soil erosion in the area.
6. Any damage done to the Plantation Unit (other than allowed for use) by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
7. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
8. The cheque/ draft amounting to Rs. 70,41,230/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.


