Sanction is hereby accorded to use of 62.70 hectare of additional forest land for establishment of Central University, Jammu, at village Bagla (Samba) by the Higher Education Department in Compartment No: 12/Balole & 17/Balole in Jammu Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The User Agency shall pay the following amount prior to execution of Project:-

- (b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/State Forest Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be borne by the User Agency.
- 3. The felling of Khair trees/ poles shall not be allowed unless permission to this effect is obtained by the user agency from the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
- 4. (a) The User Agency shall be allowed to fell only those trees/ poles which are actually required to be felled and it shall be ensured that no other tree/ pole/ sapling is felled or damaged while raising the infrastructure for the University campus.
 - (b) While taking over the area User Agency shall arrange to identify and mark Tree Numbers for 585 Khair trees 930 other trees larger than 30 cm dbh for proper silvicultural upkeep of the forest crop.
 - (c) Out turn of any tree naturally uprooted or dried shall be intimated and handed over to the Forest Department.
- 5. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- 6. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
- 7. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
- 8. (a) The User Agency shall clear the outstanding of ₹ 2,11,05,238/- of the case (Part-I) sanctioned vide Govt. Order No. 340-FST of 2010 Dated: 27.08.2010.
 - (b) The User Agency shall clear the old FCA outstanding amounting to ₹ 28,66,648/- for the cases sanctioned earlier.
 - (c) This is in line with the assurance given by the Commissioner/ Secretary (Forests) to the CAG Public Accounts Committee in the meeting held on 10.11.2012.

- The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 6,50,64,800/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
- 10. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 11. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- 12. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
