Note: - Broad-leaved species include Kau, Kainth, Champ, Anrdana, Dhaman, Kaimbal, Shisham, Darenk Ailanthus, Dhaman, Oak etc.

3. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
4. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
5. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
6. (a) The User Agency shall clear old FCA outstanding amounting to ₹ 7,21,09,442/- for the cases sanctioned earlier in Jammu Region.
(b) The CCF, Jammu, shall pursue with the Revenue authorities for assessment of cost of land in the earlier cases wherever required.
(c) This is in line with the assurance given by the Commissioner/Secy. (Forests) to the CAG Public Accounts Committee in the meeting held on 10-11-2012.

7. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 14,59,07,580/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
8. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
