- 2. Number of Trees / Poles/ Saplings involved: Nil.
- 3. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- 4. The forest land so allowed for use shall be return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency £nd after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.

- 5 The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
- 6. The cheque/ draft amounting to ₹ 52,425/- on account of various heads as detailed above shall be deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
- 7. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- 8. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented.
- 9. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
