- (b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/ Divisional Forest Officer concerned on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Director, Social Forestry Department. *The cost of extraction and transportation shall be paid by the User Agency directly to the agency executing the extraction.*

- Any damage done to the forest on the environment by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.

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3. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
4. The cheque draft amounting to ₹ 3,20,33,306/- on account of various heads as detailed above has been deposited with the Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K.
