Subject: Revised proposal for diversion of 0.75 hectares of forest land for construction of Km 2nd Nagar Lanchan road to Kansar in Bhadarwah Forest Division.

Sanction is hereby accorded to diversion of 0.75 hectares of forest land for construction of Km 2nd Nagar Lanchan road to Kansar under PMGSY in Compartment Nos. 15/N & 18a/N, Block Duggi-II, Range Neeru of Bhaderwah Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

- (i) The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- (ii) The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented under close supervision of the concerned Forest Department Officers.
- (iii) The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
- (iv) The current proposal has been revised by avoiding the stretch of proposed length of road between village Dugi to village Kansar i.e. from Km 7.7 to Km 15.70 in order to reduce the No. of trees to be felled. The extension of the same shall not be permitted in future.
- (v) Forest land will be handed over to the User Agency only after payment of following amount to the Forest Department. Extraction of Trees/Poles will not be allowed till full payment is made:

i	Net Present Value	₹ 7,43,300/-
ii	Compensation of trees / poles	₹ 9,21,840 /-
iii	Compensatory Afforestation	₹ 1,05,000/-
vi	Road side avenue plantation	₹ 6,90,000/-
Total:		₹ 24,60,140/-

(b) The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/Divisional Forest Officer concerned on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. *The cost*

of extraction and transportation shall be paid by the User Agency directly to the agency executing the extraction

- (vii) The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls as per approved plan and design of the project and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the track. The Forest Department shall take due cognizance under law for any laxity on this account on the part of the User Agency which might trigger soil erosion in the area.
- (viii) The User Agency shall be responsible for the eco-restoration of the muck dumping sites identified on forest land through engineering and biological means and by keeping due provision in the revised DPR for the same.
- (ix) The User Agency, in view of the reduced Road Land Width and for the eco-restoration of the muck dumping sites, shall get the DPR revised and approved by the competent authority prior to the execution of the project.
- (x) Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- (xi) The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency and after rehabilitated properly by the User Agency.
- (xii) The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
