Sanction is hereby accorded to the use of 0.279 hectare of Strip Plantation area (State land) of Social Forestry Division, Jammu, coming in widening of Khour – Ramgarh - Pakhuri road by GREF in S.F.Block Bishnah, S. F. Range, Vijaypur of Social Forestry Division, Jammu, subject to the the following terms and conditions:-

- (i) The land involved shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented under close supervision of the concerned Forest Department Officers.
(ii) The User Agency has paid the following amount prior to execution of the project:-

i	Compensation of trees /poles / saplings	₹ 61,000/-
ii	Road side avenue plantation	₹ 5,40,000/-
Total:		₹ 6,01,000/-

- (iii) a. Number of Trees / Poles / saplings involved:

Species	Trees (30-40cm & above)	Poles (20-30cm & 10-20cm)	Saplings (0-10cm)	Total
Broad-leaved Eucalyptus, Kikar, Bainth, Jamun, Shisham, Siris.	18	24	-	42
Total:	18	24	-	42

- b. The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/ Social Forestry Department on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Director, Social Forestry Department. The payment of extraction and transportation shall be made by the User Agency directly to the agency executing the extraction..

- (iv) The User Agency, in addition to the usual engineering measures prescribed in the DPR such as retaining walls, breast walls, side drains etc., shall also include the equally important road side avenue plantation all along the length of the road and for this, the user agency shall get the DPR accordingly revised and approved by the competent authority before execution of the project.
- (v) The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
- (vi) a) *The User Agency shall clear FCA Outstanding amounting to ₹ 8.62 Crore (ending Feb, 2013) for the GREF cases sanctioned earlier in Jammu Region.*
b) *The CCF, Jammu, shall pursue with User Agency to clear the outstanding and with the Revenue authorities for assessment of cost of land in the old cases wherever required for its further recovery from the User Agency.*
c) *This is in line with the assurance given by the Commissioner/Secy. (Forests) to the CAG Public Accounts Committee in the meeting held on 10-11-2012.*
