Sanction is hereby accorded to the use of 29.75 hectare of forest land for construction of 560 MW Kwar HEP by the CVPP Pvt. Ltd. in Compartments No. 3c/ N, 16/ N & 17/ N, Block Chirool - I, Chirool - II, Puller Range Nagseni of Kishtwar Forest Division subject to the the following terms and conditions:-

- (i) The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- (ii) The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented under close supervision of the concerned Forest Department Officers.
- (iii) The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
- (iv) The User Agency has paid the following amount prior to execution of the project:-

i	Net Present Value	₹ 2,66,85,750/-
ii	Compensation of trees /poles	₹ 34,79,100/-
iii	Compensatory Afforestation	₹ 41,65,000/-
iv	Cost of transplantation of Saplings	₹ 62,000/-
v	Compensation for damage	₹ 50,000/-
Total:		₹ 3,44,41,850/-

- b. The extraction of the trees/ poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/ DFO concerned on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. *The cost of extraction and transportation shall be done by the User Agency directly to the agency executing the extraction.*
- (vi) *The User Agency shall execute the work after the Forest Department has transplanted the saplings involved in the nearby Closure/ Nursery.*
- (vii) *The User Agency shall be responsible for the eco-restoration of the muck dumping sites through engineering and biological means as proposed in the Muck Disposal Plan.*
- (viii) *The User Agency shall execute the work only after the environment clearance of the project is obtained from the Ministry of Environment and Forests.*
- (ix) User Agency shall undertake a comprehensive catchment area treatment plan and it will be responsible for proper Muck disposal at specified location and its proper compaction and consolidation with engineering and vegetative methods.
- (x) Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- (xi) The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.
- (xii) The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
