Subject: Use of 2.67 hectare of forest land for Construction of 2.00 MW MHP Balti-Kulan Nallah District Ganderbal by JAKEDA in Sindh Forest Division.

Sanction is hereby, accorded to the use of 2.67 hectare of forest land for construction of 2.00 MW MHP, Balti Kulan Nallah, District Ganderbal by JAKEDA in Sindh Forest Division subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented, that too under close supervision and periodical spot inspection of the concerned Forest Department Officers. The reports of the concerned DCF shall be submitted to the FAC Cell in the office of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K with copies to the Administrative Department.
3. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
4. Construction will be allowed on forest land only after payment of amount summarized above is made to the Forest Department and Government sanction is issued in the case:

5. The User Agency shall pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined as per decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

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6. The extraction of the trees /poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/Divisional Forest Officer concerned on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Kashmir. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be paid by the User Agency directly to the agency executing the extraction.
7. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls on forest land and all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road in consultation with the Soil Conservation Department. The Forest Department shall take due cognizance under law for any laxity on this account on the part of the User Agency which might trigger soil erosion in the area.
8. The User Agency shall be responsible for the eco-restoration of the muck dumping sites identified on forest land through engineering and biological means.
9. The user agency will install fish screen at weir site or at fore bay site.
10. Muck dumping sites will be protected with RCC retaining walls and area should be developed as a park.
11. Monitoring of the project will be done by the Soil and Water Conservation Department and JAKEDA.
12. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
13. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.
14. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
15. The sanction will remain valid for one year.
