by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Kashmir. *The cost of extraction and transportation shall be paid by the User Agency directly to the agency executing the extraction.*

7. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/ breast walls on forest land and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the pond. Muck generated during the execution of the project shall be utilized locally. The Forest Department shall take due cognizance under law for any laxity on this account on the part of the User Agency which might trigger soil erosion in the area.
8. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
9. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.
10. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
11. The sanction will remain valid for one year.
