Sanction is hereby accorded to the use of 0.42 hectare of forest land for laying of 33 KV overhead line through forest land from Janghi Morh to Nashiri Bridge by NHAI in Compartments No. 14 b/Btt and 14 c/Btt, Block Batote, Range Batote of Batote Forest Division, subject to the the following terms and conditions:-

- (i) The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- (ii) The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented that too under close supervision and periodical spot inspection of the concerned Forest Department Officers. The reports of the concerned DCF shall be submitted to FAC cell in the O/o PCCF, J&K with copies to Administrative Department.
- (iii) The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
- (iv) The User Agency has paid the following amount prior to execution of the project:-

ii	Compensation of trees /poles	₹ 1,29,600/-

b. No trees are to be felled.

- (vi) The User Agency shall execute the work after the Forest Department has transplanted the saplings involved in the nearby Closure/ Nursery.
- (vii) The User Agency shall be responsible for the eco-restoration of the muck dumping sites identified on Forest land / State land / Private land through engineering and biological means and by keeping due provision in the revised DPR for the same.
- (viii) Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
- (ix) The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.
- (x) User Agency shall not be allowed to dump debris on forest land.
- (xi) The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
