Subject: Use of 2.33 hectare of forest land for construction of road from Tandar to Charat via Pakhlai by PMGSY in Udhampur Forest Division.

Sanction is hereby accorded to the use of 2.33 hectare of forest land for construction of road from Tandar to Charat via Pakhlai by PMGSY in Compartment No. 77/U & 80/U, Block Charat Pakhlai, Range Udhampur of Udhampur Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

- The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented, that too under close supervision and periodical spot inspection of the concerned Forest Department Officers. The reports of the concerned DCF shall be submitted to the FAC Cell in the office of PCCF with copies to the Administrative Department.
- The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
- Construction will be allowed on forest land only after payment of amount summarized below to the Forest Department and Govt. sanction is issued in the case:-

i	Net Present Value	₹ 19,68,850
ii	Compensatory Afforestation	₹ 4,66,000
iii	Roadside plantation	₹ 13,35,000
iv	Compensation of trees	₹ 10,05,000
Total:		₹ 47,74,850

- a) Number of Trees / Poles / saplings involved:

Species	Trees (30-40cm & above)	Poles (20-30cm & 10-20cm)	Saplings (0-10cm)	Total
Chir Green	152	15	2	169

- b) The extraction of the trees /poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/Divisional Forest Officer concerned on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be paid by the User Agency directly to the agency executing the extraction.

- The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast wall (190m RW & 130m BW) on forest land and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to

- proposed construction of the road in consultation with the Soil Conservation Department. The Forest Department shall take due cognizance under law for any laxity on this account on the part of the User Agency which might trigger soil erosion in the area.
- vii. The User Agency in view of the reduced Road Land Width shall get the DPR revised and approved by the competent authority prior to the execution of the project.
 - viii. The User Agency shall be responsible for the eco-restoration of the muck dumping sites identified on forest land through engineering and biological means and keeping due provision in the revised DPR for the same.
 - ix. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
 - x. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.
 - xi. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
 - xii. The sanction will remain valid for 2 years and in case the construction work is not taken up within this period by the User Agency, the sanction will be automatically cancelled.
