Sanction is, hereby, accorded to the use of 1.875 Ha. of forest land for construction of road from Bamayala to Kantha (Part-I) by PMGSY in Nowshera Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented, that too under close supervision and periodical spot inspection.

- 3 The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by the User Agency in any manner, what so ever, to any other agency.
4. The User Agency has made the payment in full of the amount summarized below, as reported by the PCCF, vide letter mentioned at Ref.(iii)

ii	Compensatory Afforestation	3,75,000
iii	Compensation of trees	2,68,439
iv	Roadside plantation	17,25,000

5. Construction, if any approved in the proposal, will be allowed on forest land only after the Government sanction is issued in the case.
6. (i) The extraction of the trees/poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/Divisional Forest Officer concerned on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu. The marking for tree felling will be done in consultation with the User Agency and effort shall be made to save maximum number of trees. The cost of extraction and transportation shall be paid by the User Agency directly to the agency executing the extraction.
- (ii) The fundamental rule for marking of trees, enumerated during processing of the instant proposal, will be to save maximum number of trees without compromising with the construction and maintenance of the approved project structures and no trees will be felled/cut/pruned/lopped for purposes/project activities other than those approved/sanctioned.
7. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls and dry edge wall (275m /RW, 370m /BW & 180m /EW) on forest land and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road in consultation with the Soil Conservation Department. The Forest Department shall take due cognizance under law for any laxity on this account on the part of the User Agency which might trigger soil erosion in the area.
8. The User Agency in view of the reduced Road Land Width shall get the DPR revised and approved by the competent authority prior to the execution of the project.
9. The User Agency shall be responsible for the eco-restoration of the muck dumping sites identified on forest land through engineering and biological means and keeping due provision in the revised DPR for the same.
10. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
11. The User Agency and/ or its contractors will not bring any forest area under their use, other than the actual area/activity approved by the Government for instant proposal. Any laxity or deviation on this account by the user agency or its contractors will attract penal provisions of the relevant Acts/legal provision.

12. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.
13. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project..
14. The sanction will remain valid for one year.
