Sanction is hereby, accorded to the use of 1.85 Ha of forest land for construction of road from Nud to Bharat Garh by PMGSY in Kathua Forest Division, subject to the following terms and conditions:-

- The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- The forest land shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been indented, that too under close supervision and periodical spot inspection of the concerned Forest Department Officers. The reports of the concerned DCF shall be submitted to the FAC Cell in the office of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, J&K with copies to the Administrative Department.
- The forest land shall not be mortgaged, reassigned, leased or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
- The user Agency has made the payment in full of the amount summarized below, as reported by the Nodal Officer FCA, vide letter mentioned at Ref(iii).

- Construction, if any, will be allowed on the forest land only after full payment of the amount summarized above is made to the Forest Department by the user agency and Govt. sanction is issued in the case.
- The extraction of the trees /poles shall be done by the State Forest Corporation/Divisional Forest Officer concerned on the basis of markings administratively approved by the Chief

7. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls on forest land and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction of the road in consultation with the Soil Conservation Department. The Forest Department shall take due cognizance under law for any laxity on this account on the part of the User Agency which might trigger soil erosion in the area.
8. The User Agency in view of the reduced Road Land Width shall get the DPR revised and approved by the competent authority prior to the execution of the project.
9. The User Agency shall be responsible for the eco-restoration of the muck dumping sites identified on forest land through engineering and biological means and keeping due provision in the revised DPR for the same. Monitoring of the muck-dumping sites will be done by the Soil & Water Conservation Department and report be placed before the Committee.
10. Any damage done to the forest by the User Agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the User Agency @ 10 times the standard rate of 1992.
11. The forest land so allowed for use shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.
12. The User Agency shall be responsible for obtaining requisite clearances under any other law in vogue before commissioning of the project.
13. The sanction will remain valid for one year.
