Subject:- Diversion of forest land for construction of Ludnoo Bridge to Dugnu Dhar road (RD Km 3rd to Km 7th) by PWD .

Sanction is hereby accorded for the diversion of forest land to the extent of 1.547 Ha. for construction of Ludnoo Bridge Dugnu Dhar road (RD Km 3rd to Km 7th) by PWD in Comptt.No:31/BLR and 32/BLR of Billawar Forest Division strictly under the provisions of J&K Forest Conservation Act on the following terms and conditions:-

1. The proprietary status of the forest land shall remain un-changed.
2. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or subleased by user agency in any manner whatsoever to any other agency.
4. The User Agency shall pay the Net Present Value of the land to the tune of Rs.12,65,446/- as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Order Dt:30.10.2002 in I.A. No: 566 in W Petition (Civil) No: 202 of 1995 T.N. Godavarman Thirumalpad V/s Union of India.
5. The User Agency shall be bound to pay an amount of Rs.12,41,150 on account of compensation of 752 numbers of trees/poles of different species and dia-classes.
6. The user agency shall be bound to pay an amount of Rs.77,350 on account of Compensatory Afforestation to be carried over double the area diverted i.e.3.094 II
7. The extraction of trees shall be done by State Forest Corporation/Forest Department on the basis of marking lists technically sanctioned by Conservator of Forests Working Plan and Research Circle and administratively approved by Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu.
8. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from user agency at the rate ten times the standard rate of 1992.
9. The user agency shall take all necessary steps to check soil erosion likely to occur due to the intending construction of road.
10. The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department free of any encumbrances when it is no longer required by the User Agency.
11. The user agency shall also pay any other amount which will come payable as per orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court or Government/Forest Department, J&K
12. The user agency shall submit an undertaking that in case of an upward revision of rates of Net Present Value, the user agency will pay the amount of differential Net Present Value.
13. The user agency shall be responsible to obtain requisite clearance under any other law in vogue.
14. The money on account of various heads to be paid by the user agency as detailed above shall be deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the office of PCCF.
