As such, all the CCFs/CFs & DFOs/POs/ Principals are requested to ensure the registration and enrolment of all the employees working under their administrative control , on the iGOT Karmayogi Portal (https://igotkarmayogi.gov.in) and furnish the action taken reports so that the same can be submitted to the Administrative Department.
